English Plus Digital Media SkillsIntensive Summer course

This short course gives you the opportunity to:

- learn skills and techniques in, and explore ideas in, digital media creation
- improve your English, and practise by discussing things that you are interested in
- experience London
- make new friends with students from around the world on our large English summer programme

The course will include:

- 15 hours of English classes per week, Monday to Friday.
- 10 hours of Digital Media activities and classes over four days per week
- use of the specialised facilities and studios in our modern Wandsworth campus
- self-study facilities, including materials on stcBlackboard; free internet access
- certificate of attendance

Digital Media Skills

- This course is an introduction to creating digital media content using software such as Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Dreamweaver, Final Cut and using HTML
- It will help you build confidence to develop new ideas and projects still or moving images and sound and help you to present your creative work visually and verbally
- Advice about visits to London museums, galleries and events, and how to use them for creative ideas and inspiration

English

- Classes will help you improve all your language skills: grammar, vocabulary, reading, writing, listening, comprehension (understanding), speaking & pronunciation
- You will also learn about UK Life and Culture and "the London experience"





Admissions Requirements

- This course is an introduction to digital media, so you do not need experience or previous study of this
- English level; equivalent to IELTS 4.5 overall; you can use the College English test
- Suitable for adult students of all ages

- English classes are 09:00 12:30, Monday to Friday
- Digital Media classes are 13:30 16:15, Monday to Thursday
- The course is at our modern Wandsworth campus
- The course fee for 4 weeks is £995
